### GENERAL GUIDELINES

The abstract submission is only possible on-line. Abstracts submitted by other means or not compliant with the instructions will not be accepted.

- You may be the **presenting author** of any number of abstracts.
- All accepted submissions will either be presented as **posters** or as **oral presentations**.
- All abstracts must be submitted in **English**.
- There is no fee for abstract submission but **presenting authors must be registered participants** of the congress and **registration is mandatory by 6 May 2024**
- Accepted abstracts will be published (on line) on a **Special Issue of the Journal of Peptide Science**

Please carefully follow the instructions before submitting the abstract. The abstract will be online for editing by the submitter until the submission deadline.

All submitted abstracts will be reviewed by the scientific committee after the submission deadline. Acceptance will be notified **ONLY to the presenting author within 22 April 2024**.

### YOUNG INVESTIGATOR MINI SYMPOSIUM (YIMS) and DR. BERT L. SCHRAM BEST ORAL PRESENTATION AWARDS

(two awards sponsored by ESCOM Science Foundation)

The Presenting author who is a **PhD student or early post-doc < 3 years** at the time of submission will be eligible to participate in the “**Young Investigator Mini Symposium**” (YIMS), a special session of the Symposium fully dedicated to young investigators. The two best oral presentations will be awarded.

To apply for YIMS participations and Awards please be ready to upload the mandatory documents (PDF format) in the submission website:

- One-page Curriculum Vitae;
- Motivation letter;
- Support letter of the supervisor

### DR. BERT L. SCHRAM BEST POSTER PRESENTATION AWARDS (six awards sponsored by ESCOM Science Foundation)

The Presenting author who is a **PhD student or early post-doc < 3 years** at the time of submission will be eligible to participate in the **Best Poster Presentation Award**.

To apply for Best Poster Presentation Awards please be ready to upload the mandatory document (PDF format) in the submission website:

- One-page Curriculum Vitae.

## ABSTRACT TEXT PREPARATION

- The abstract must be written in **English**. The word text to be uploaded on the submission page should contain **only the ABSTRACT TEXT not title and authors** (title, authors and affiliations will be merged to the abstract text automatically).
- Abstract **text** must not exceed **400 words**.
- Type your abstract in a common Word Processor (e.g., Microsoft Word). Save a copy of the file with the **abstract text only (no title or authors)** and be ready to upload it on the submission page.
- **Up to THREE References** can be typed at the end of the abstract and are counted as text.
- **A maximum of one Graphic, picture or table** is allowed and should be included in the text.
- Please ensure that your abstract does not contain spelling, grammatical or scientific errors, as it will be reproduced exactly as submitted.
- Please note that, **no advertising** can be inserted, only generic names may be given (for drugs, tools, deans) and must not return any trade name.

## STEP BY STEP ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

- Carefully read the **General Conditions** to give your acceptance.
- Select one **Category** (topic) that you think relates most to your abstract (please check the below list)
- Type the abstract **Title**.  
Abbreviations are not allowed in the title.  
In the title, please use capital letters and italics **ONLY** where necessary.
- Select the preferred **Type of presentation** (oral or poster); please note that the final decision about the type of presentation is up to the Scientific Committee. Authors asking for oral presentation are invited to submit a short "expertise and motivation statement" (max 1.000 characters, optional), which will be considered by the Scientific Committee.
- Type your custom **Keywords**. Minimum ONE – Maximum THREE
- Add all **Authors** and **Affiliations**.  
The order as well as the name of the presenting author can be edited during the submission process.
- Select the **Presenting author**.  
Presenting authors are expected to attend the congress and present their contribution. Authors who are unable to attend and give the presentation as scheduled, must notify the Organizing Secretariat OIC and withdraw their abstract at [AbstractEPS-IPS2024@oic.it](mailto:AbstractEPS-IPS2024@oic.it)
- Complete the **Additional queries** fields related to the Presenting author for:
  - **Expertise and motivation statement for oral presentation**
  - **Awards**
- **Upload** the word file with your abstract text.
- Check the **Summary** and the **Preview** and finally click on the **Submit** button which appears only if all steps have been completed. If the Submit button is not available at the bottom of the webpage, please check the "Todo's" list (right upper side of the page) to see which step is incomplete.
